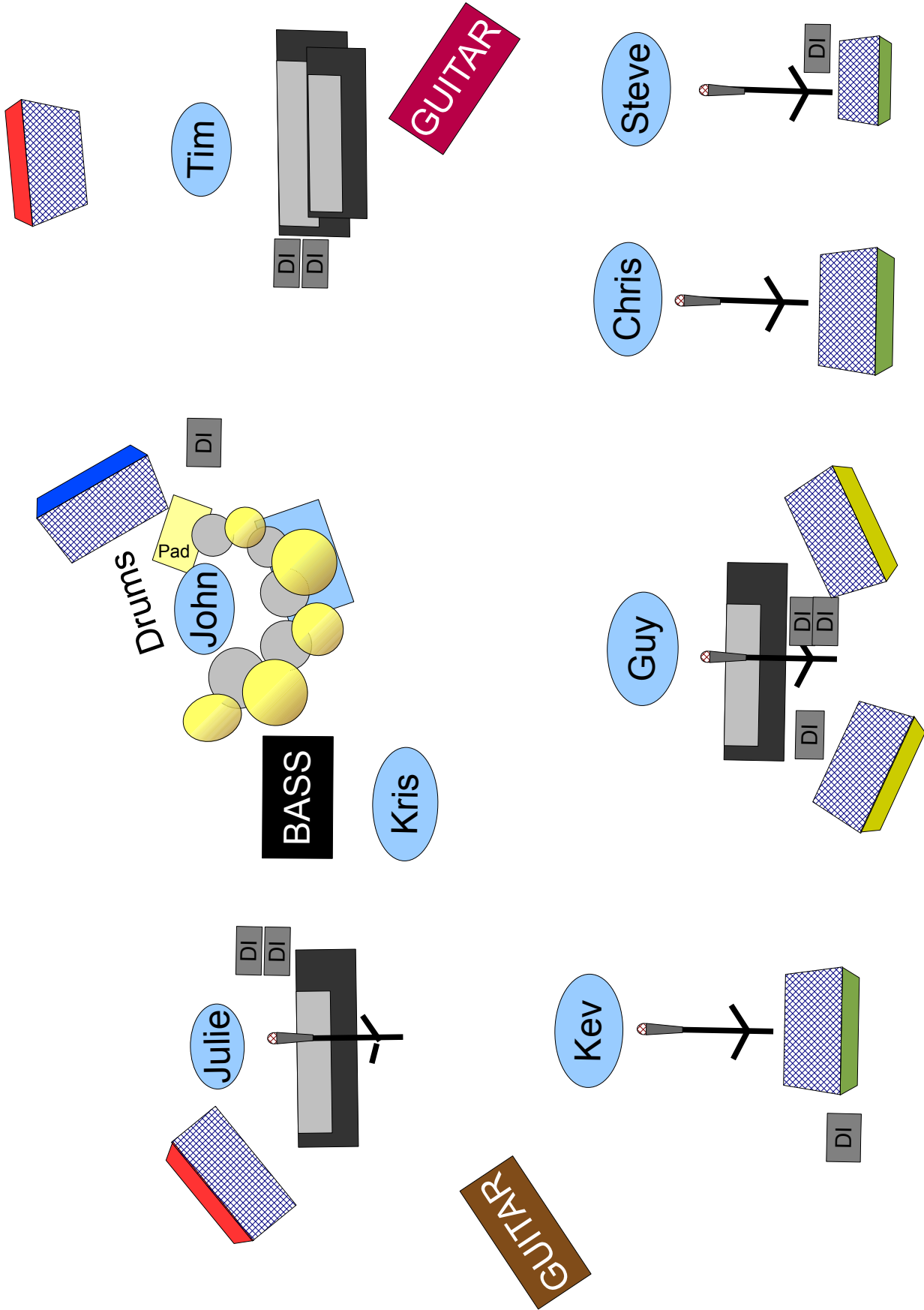

Hospitality Rider
(where applicable)

To be provided by the host/promoter:

A good quality PA system suitable for the size of venue with a minimum of 24 channels and a good selection of good quality good condition microphones, outboard effects, gates, compressors.

4 channels of monitoring into 7 monitors paired up as coloured on the main stage plan. If 5 channels are available, the keyboard monitors should be split.

An competent in house sound engineer with a good knowledge of the system. Depending on the gig we may bring our own engineer.

One good sized, clean, tidy, well lit and heated dressing room to be provided within easy reach of the stage. The dressing room should have seating, tables, a mirror and electrical power.

One table, of a minimum size of 2' by 3' for the sale of merchandise, located within easy reach of the main area of the venue and also adjacent to an electrical socket.

Food and drink to be provided at no cost to the band:

Facilities for making tea, coffee including sugar and milk.

6 cans diet coke

6 cans coke

6 cans Fanta/Tango or similar orange drink

24 bottles water with sports caps

1 Litre juice (orange, pineapple or cranberry)

12 cans/bottles of a selection of good quality lagers and beers.

If food is specified, please provide:

NOTE : One of the party is a STRICT vegetarian – no meat, fish OR DERIVATIVES – please ensure all cheeses are vegetarian (no animal rennet) and that meats and cheeses are kept separate and handled using separate utensils.

Snack foods from arrival to departure to consist of:

Breads, meats and cheeses

Breadsticks

Dips (Hummous, Taramasalata, Garlic etc.)

Crisps, Chocolate & other such snacks.

Main meal to be provided between Sound check ending and doors opening.

A well balanced hot meal (or buy out) to be provided for EIGHT people
(NINE if engineer is with band)

No junk food or excessively cheesy food, Pizzas, Burgers etc.
